Lewis Scott held the meeting as Oscar Yang had show selection; everything is going smoothly. The Stage Manager will be running the get-in and the plans look good. They have just tested the bungie cord with Toby Molyneux.

f. Catja Hamilton to fill us in on how Lighting and Sound are going for *Britannia*. All is well. g. Ellie Mitchell to decline the Clare Actors request. Done.

## 4. Show Reports

- a. *24 Hour Plays* (ADC Theatre, Show Contact: Saskia Baylis and Oscar Yang) No show report received but everything is going well.
- b. Panto (ADC Theatre, Show Contact: Ellie Mitchell)
  - **S** Obviously fine.

P – There is a Sound budget issue; it is going to be £200 over budget at the moment due to changes to equipment sources. Alan Egan is currently working out ways to bring the spend back under budget.

A – Rehearsals are going well; the choreography is complex but is being learnt!

**T** – The build is finished, so there is just painting to complete! Quote Toby Molyneux with his mouth full: 'We're weally weally far ahead'. The revolve mechanics have suffered a small blip but are being fixed!

c. Rules for Living (ADC Theatre, Show Contact: Oscar Yang)
